Capt Vincent Gallagher was born in Dublin, Ireland and immigrated to the United States in 1987.

Capt Gallagher is a Construction Estimator and has worked in the construction industry since 1987 in various positions including Foreman, Superintendent, Project Manager, Chief Estimator and Vice President. He is currently an Estimating Manager with Turner Construction Company in the Special Projects Division in Dallas, Texas. His job includes supervising bid teams on a variety of different types of projects including data centers, manufacturing facilities, retail locations and office renovations and build outs. He is a LEED Accredited Professional by the United States Green Building Institute and a Certified Construction Document Technologist from the Construction Specifications Institute.

Capt Gallagher joined the Civil Air Patrol as a Second Lieutenant in 2001 and was assigned to the Denton Texas Composite Squadron as Logistics Officer and subsequently as Squadron Commander.

After serving four years as the Logistics Officer and One Year as Commander, he was selected to move to the Southwest Region as Logistics Officer. The Southwest Region encompasses 6 states, including Arkansas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Texas, Arizona, and New Mexico.
